The story of Motown began in 1959 in Detroit, Michigan.

Companies in Detroit made the most cars in the U.S.A. (1) It was called Motor Town.

Berry Gordy Jr. wanted to make music, not cars. He left his job at a car factory. He started a record company called Motown, short for Motor Town.

He bought a small house on West Grand Boulevard for Motown's office. The sign above the door said, "Hitsville, U.S.A." because he wanted to make hit records.

(2) Mr. Gordy's Motown Sound changed the world. It brought people of different races together to listen to this new music.

The Funk Brothers played instruments to create the Motown Sound. They played the piano, guitars, drums and horns.

Some famous Motown performers include Diana Ross, Smokey Robinson, and Stevie Wonder.

(3) Even Michael Jackson recorded songs for Motown. He sang hits, like ABC, with his brothers in a group called the Jackson 5.

Sixty years ago, Motown music was new and exciting. Singers still use the Motown Sound today.
